### **Bereaved Families of Ontario – Kingston Region Quilt Raffle Rules & Regulations**

Prizes: First Prize – Large Quilt (103”x103”), valued at \$2500  
Second Prize – Medium Quilt (56”x86”), valued at \$1000  
Third Prize – Large Wooden Bowl, valued at \$200

Total Value in Prizes: \$3700

1. A maximum of 2000 tickets will be available at a cost of \$5 for 1 (one).
2. Tickets will be available from February 1, 2023 to June 4, 2023, or until maximum number of tickets are sold.
3. Grand Prize Draw will take place at 2:00 PM on June 4, 2023 at 130 Days Road, Kingston, ON.
4. Tickets may only be sold or purchased in Ontario.
5. Bereaved Families of Ontario – Kingston Region is not responsible for any disputes that may arise between the individuals who have purchased tickets. Names of persons under 18 year of age shall not appear on any Ticket Stubs, in trust or otherwise.
6. Individual purchasers of raffle tickets must be 18 years of age or older.
7. Bereaved Families of Ontario – Kingston Region shall appoint a single individual who will be responsible for maintaining control and security of all of the Raffle ticket stubs. Such individual shall, by public certification under oath at the time of the drawing, certify that all Raffle tickets purchased have their stub in the container of stubs where the winning Raffle ticket will be drawn.
8. You do not need to be present to win. Winners will be contacted by phone within 48 hours of the draw taking place.
9. At the designated time, three stubs will be randomly drawn from all of the sold tickets. The first stub will receive the first prize (large quilt), the second stub will receive the second prize (medium quilt), and the third stub will receive the third prize (large wooden bowl).
10. Prizes are not transferrable and must be accepted as awarded, there will be no cash substitutes.
11. The prize winner will be responsible for license, insurance and registration fees associated with the prize if applicable local and provincial regulations. Raffle ticket purchase is not a tax deductible contribution or donation.
12. The Raffle is subject to all applicable federal, provincial, and local laws and regulations, and is void wherever prohibited or restricted by law.
13. By participating, each participant releases, discharges, indemnifies, and holds harmless Bereaved Families of Ontario – Kingston Region and its respective officers, directors, employees, agents and representatives, advertising agencies, and promotional partners

from any and all liability, loss, harm, injury, damage, cost, and expense whatsoever arising directly or indirectly from participation in this raffle.

14. For any reason if the raffle is canceled, Bereaved Families of Ontario – Kingston Region must notify all ticket purchasers in writing and reimburse each Raffle ticket purchaser the price of the ticket within sixty (60) days of the cancellation date. Bereaved Families of Ontario – Kingston Region's liability is limited to the purchase price of the ticket.
15. Approximate retail value as of date contracts were negotiated with suppliers. Due to market fluctuations, the market value of the prizes may rise or diminish over time. Winner or charity is not entitled to the difference, if any, between the stated and actual market value at the time the prize is awarded.
16. Use of Lottery Proceeds from the raffle will be in accordance with AGCO (Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario) approved guidelines by the Lottery Licensing Officer.
